

Scholarship Program
North Carolina Association of Agricultural Fairs

Purpose: To assist high school seniors who are continuing their education by pursuing a degree in a four or two-year college or university.

Awards: A \$2400.00 scholarship to a student who plans to enroll in a four-year institution or a \$1200.00 scholarship to a student who plans to enroll in a two-year accredited institution.

Applicant Rules:

- 1) Applicants must be a high school senior and a resident of North Carolina.
- 2) Applicants must return the completed application forms to the sponsoring fair on a date determined by the sponsoring fair.
- 3) All questions on the application form must be answered.
- 4) Grade transcripts are required with all applications.
- 5) The financial need statement form must be completed if applying for financial need-based applications.
- 6) Awards will be made through the Financial Aid Office of the university or college. These funds will be distributed in **one payment**. These funds must be credited directly toward tuition, fees or books.
- 7) Scholarship recipients must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative grade point average. If the required grade point average is not maintained, scholarship funds will be withheld. However, the funds can be reinstated if the grade point average is attained at the end of the term for which the funds were withheld.
- 8) If a student withdraws from college, any refund due will return to the NCAOAF Scholarship Fund.
- 9) If awarded a scholarship, student must be enrolled in college before one calendar year passes or they forfeit their scholarship. If awarded a \$2400.00 scholarship and then decides to attend a community college the award will be reduced to \$1200.00.

The NCAOAF Scholarship Committee will use the following basis for scoring the applications:

Category I -- Financial Need

In the event of a tie, the applicant with the highest fair involvement scores will be the winner.
